Dear Naples Lakes Country Club Member:

On the reverse side of this letter you will find a summary of the Final 2021 Budget approved by the Board of Directors during the October 28, 2020 Board Meeting. The Club Staff, the Finance Committee and your Board of Directors spent a considerable amount of time scrutinizing the income and expenses to make sure your dues dollars are wisely spent.

As we all know 2020 has been an extremely challenging year for everyone. COVID-19 has affected everyone's life in a variety of ways. Many Clubs in southwest Florida and around the country experienced large operating losses resulting in sizable member assessments to cover their shortfalls. We are pleased to announce that there will be no additional assessments due to COVID-19's impact for Naples Lakes Country Club residents. The management team worked very diligently to obtain the best financial relief from the available programs for the benefit of the community as well as keeping spending under control.

Because of the continued economic uncertainty as we enter next year, our goal was to keep spending increases to a minimum so we could limit your dues increase. The year-over-year budget increase is \$253,004 or 3.88 percent. This equates to a dues increase of \$346 per door and is the second lowest increase in six years. Included below is an explanation of some of the major items that changed the budget from 2020.

Recurring Increases. The following increases over last year's budget are the result of ongoing contractual obligations:

- \$4,273 Security Contract Increase
- \$30,231 Cable Contract Increase
- \$17,962 Liability Blanket Policy Increase
- \$32,195 Club's share of the employee health insurance increase.

2021 Required Increases.

- \$30,590 Impact due to golf course bridge project on golf shop and food and beverage revenue.
- \$67,031 Increase per annual reserve study update.1

Together the recurring and required spending increases amount to approximately \$182,000 or 72 percent of the total increase.

The Board has also approved the following fee increases for 2021.

Fee Increases.

- Golf Guest Fees (including reciprocals and renters) will increase by \$3.
- Club Cart Rental Fees will increase \$1 for both 9- and 18-hole rounds.
- \$25 increase in the cart trail fee.

Remaining Items. The remaining budget dollars not discussed (\$70,700) represents approximately 1 percent of the 2021 budget and is spread among the various departments and operations and includes payroll and other line adjustments.

¹ The yearly contribution to the Replacement Reserve is governed by NLCC policy which relies on the annual Replacement Reserve Study from an outside consultant. The increase in the Reserve Contribution for the 2021 budget over the 2020 budget is 7.14 percent.
